Photo Gallery Instructions




I've now managed to get the photo gallery working correctly, so I thought it would be the perfect time to put together a quick guide on how to use it.

The 'Photos' section of the website is divided into albums. The vast majority of these are based on operators, but there are also galleries for some bus events and museums. Smaller independent operators may be grouped together by county or region.

When you have chosen a gallery that you would like to view, click the link to take you to the gallery page. You will now see small versions of all of the photos in the gallery. Although bigger than thumbnails, these photos are small and difficult to see, and need to be enlarged.

To enlarge the photo, click on it. You should now see a large version of the photo in the centre of the screen (the photos scale to fit the display of the device that you are using). Underneath the photo, you will see a caption. Each caption will be slightly different, but should contain information about the type of vehicle, and where the photograph was taken.

To move to the next photo, hover over the right hand half of the current photo. An arrowhead should appear. Either click the arrowhead or anywhere in the right hand half of the photo to move forward. To move backwards in the album, click anywhere within the left hand half of the photo. Again, when hovering over the left hand half of the photo, an arrowhead should appear.



To return to the gallery page, click the cross underneath the bottom right hand corner of the photo, or anywhere outside of the photo. If you wish to return to index page of the 'photos' section, click on the 'Photos' link in the main menu at the top of the page, or use the 'back' button of your web browser.

Browser Compatibility

As with all parts of Scott's Transport Site, the photos section is testing using Mozilla Firefox and Opera browser, on both Ubuntu linux 18.04 and Windows 7. Where possible, the latest versions of both browsers are used. All functions are known to work on both of these browsers.

Other browsers should work, but these are intested and some functions may not work correctly. Recent versions of Opera are based on Google Chrome, meaning Google Chrome is likely to offer a similar performance compared to Opera.

The authors own observations suggest that Opera is the quickest browser, but Firefox is the better all round browser. Limited tests have shown Microsoft Edge to be slow in comparision to both Firefox and Opera.
